

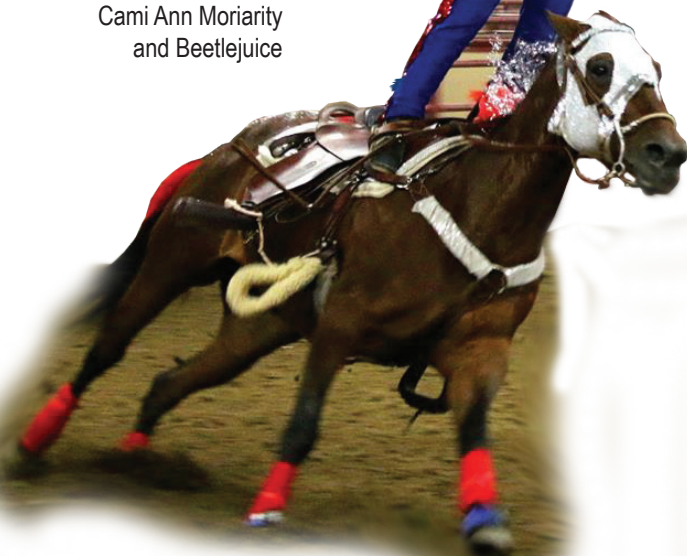

The first ever "Bling It On Futurity" was held at the 4th annual Barrels and Bling Memorial barrel race over the July 4th weekend at C Bar C Expo Center in Cloverdale, Indiana. With over \$20,000 in added money and prizes, including saddles to both the Young Guns and Youth Barrels on Saturday, drew an exciting crowd. Participants from 11 states showed up and over 1800 runs were clocked, including 42 Pee Wee and Young Guns!
